5. Enforcement Statistics and Performance Measures

Nancy Gaytan, Enforcement Analyst, presented enforcement statistics for July 2016 to March 2017. During this period, there were 45 complaints and 91 convictions and/or arrests; 25 citations were issued; nine cases were referred to the California State Attorney General's Office; and the number of probationers increased to 41.

Ms. Gaytan then presented performance measures for October 2016 to December 2016. All enforcement actions during this period were completed with greater time efficiency than the time allowed in the performance measure stated goals.



Performance Measures was established by DCA in order for each Board, Bureau or Committee to review its progress toward meeting its enforcement goals and targets.

Volume: 44 Total (8 Consumer complaints, 36 Conviction reports)

Number of complaints and convictions received per guarter

Cycle Time:

- Intake Target: 30 days
 Average number of days from complaint receipt, to the date the complaint was closed or assigned to an investigator.
- Investigations Target: 270 Days
 Average number of days to complete the entire enforcement process for cases not transmitted to the Attorney General (AG)
- Formal Discipline Target: 540 Days
 Average number of days to complete the entire enforcement process for cases resulting in formal discipline (includes intake and investigation by the Committee and prosecution by the AG).
- Probation Intake Target: 10 Days
 Average number of days from monitor assignment, to the date the monitor makes first contact with the probationer.
- Probation Violation Response Target: 10 Days
 Average number of days from the date a violation of probation is reported, to the date the assigned monitor initiates appropriate action.






Enforcement Performance Measures








PM3 | Investigations – Volume

Number of investigations closed (not including cases transmitted to the Attorney General).



(Includes intake and investigation.)



PM4 | Formal Discipline - Volume




