1. Roll Call and Establishment of a Quorum

Evangeline Ward, Chairperson of the Licensing and Examination Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at 3:48 p.m. She took roll call and a quorum was established with all four members present.

2. Public Comments for Items Not on the Agenda

3. Chairperson's Report

Chair Ward stated that there was nothing to report.

4. Approval of the December 3, 2016 Licensing and Examination Subcommittee Minutes

Motion: Nicolette Moultrie moved to adopt the December 3, 2016 Licensing and Examination Subcommittee Meeting Minutes.

Chair Ward asked if any member of the public or the Subcommittee would like to comment. There were no comments.

5. Licensure Statistics

Anthony Lum, Interim Executive Officer for the DHCC, presented the licensure statistics. He reported that BreEZe has allowed the staff to more accurately monitor licensing numbers. As of March 29, 2017, the DHCC had 18,121 active licensees; 2,116 inactive licensees; and 3,046 delinquent licensees.

The Subcommittee expressed interest in the delinquent licensees. Mr. Lum explained that there could be a number of different reasons a person's license was delinquent, but in order to assist the licensees who desire to return their licenses to good standing, the DHCC had recently sent out a letter to each licensee on the delinquent list explaining how to restore a delinquent license.

6. Written Examination Statistics

Mr. Lum presented the law and ethics written examination statistics. Seventy percent of registered dental hygienist (RDH) examinees and 75% of registered dental hygienist in alternative practice examinees earned passing scores.

Public Comment: Vickie Kimbrough requested that the data be further analyzed to show the percentage of California-trained examinees who earn passing scores compared to non-California-trained examinees who earn passing scores.

There were no further comments.

7. ADEX Presentation

The American Board of Dental Examiners (ADEX) presentation was rescheduled for the following day.

8. Future Agenda Items

Nicolette Moultrie requested a follow up from the Special Committee on Alternative Pathways to Licensure. She stated that they should address whether it is truly necessary to conduct RDH examinations with live patients when most or all other licensing boards do not use live patients.

Chair Ward stated that she would like to see more information on what could be done to ensure that the DHCC be made aware of when a candidate fails more than once to achieve a passing score on one licensure examination (such as WREB or CRDTS) then takes the other licensing exam without first having completed remedial training. Chair Ward requested the definitions for trauma and for what constitutes a critical error be gathered from both WREB and CRDTS.

There were no further comments.

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

Background

Over the past several months, staff has received information from other states (AZ, PA, MN, etc.) and licensees attempting to obtain a dental hygiene license in another state that they will no longer accept the information that is contained in the current Certification of Licensure form that the DHCC sends to other states and jurisdictions.

Because our licensees have paid the \$25 fee for this certification, staff believe that it is appropriate to revise the certification form so that the individual's licensing information is captured and conveyed to the receiving entity in a format that is easily understood.

Staff has revised the Certification of Licensure Form to reflect the changes and eliminated the narrative format to state the licensure data so it is easily read. A sample of the revised form and the current form are in the packet for your comparison.

Committee Action Requested

□ Staff requests that the Licensing Subcommittee recommend to the Full Committee to approve the proposed revision to the Certification of Licensure form so that a licensee's licensing information is sent in a clearer manner and captures what the requesting entity wants.

SUBJECT	LIC 8 - Discussion and Possible Action to Revise Business and Professions Code § 1917.4 (b) Dental Hygienist, Requirements for Licensure

Background

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code § 1917 (b), the Committee lists the requirements to issue a license as a registered dental hygienist to a person who satisfies all of them.

Currently, the language in BPC 1917 (b) does not contain a time limit for when the Committee must accept the satisfactory completion of a dental hygiene examination given by WREB, CRDTS, or the previously administered state clinical examination. This means that an applicant who has fulfilled all of the other requirements for licensure, but completed a clinical examination 8, 10, or 20 years ago could still be eligible for a license as a registered dental hygienist.

Because staff have issued licenses to applicants in this situation and knowing that the individual's clinical skills may not be at a level to safely practice, it could create a situation where consumer harm may be at risk due to the time the person has not used their clinical skills.

Staff has provided proposed statutory language which is a revision to this section to create a window of time for the committee to accept examination results to apply toward licensure.

Committee Action Requested

□ Staff requests that the Licensing Subcommittee recommend to the Full Committee to approve the proposed language for BPC § 1917.4 (b) and authorize the Interim Executive Officer to make any technical and non-substantive changes to the language and move forward with the request.

Business and Professions Code 1917 (b) Dental Hygienist, Requirements for Licensure

Amend § 1917 (b) Dental Hygienist, Requirements for Licensure to read as follows:

The Committee shall grant initial licensure as a registered dental hygienist to a person who satisfies all of the following requirements:

- (a) Completion of an educational program for registered dental hygienists approved by the committee, accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation, and conducted by a degree-granting, postsecondary institution.
- (b) <u>Within the preceding five years</u>, Satisfactory performance on the state clinical examination, or satisfactory completion of the dental hygiene examination given by the Western Regional Examining Board or any other clinical <u>or</u> dental hygiene examination approved by the committee.
- (c) Satisfactory completion of the National Dental Hygiene Board Examination.
- (d) Satisfactory completion of the examination in California law and ethics as prescribed by the committee.
- (e) Submission of a completed application form and all fees required by the committee.
- (f) Satisfactory completion of committee-approved instruction in gingival soft tissue curettage, nitrous oxide-oxygen analgesia, and local anesthesia.
