SUBJECT	Agenda Item 3 - Update on Little Hoover Commission Hearings

The Little Hoover Commission recently began a review of occupational licensing in California and conducted two public hearings in February and March of 2016. The focus of the Commission's review is to determine the following:

- 1) The impact of occupational licensing on upward mobility and opportunities for entrepreneurship and innovation for Californians, particularly those of modest means.
- 2) Examine the impact of occupational licensing on the cost and availability of services provided by licensed practitioners to consumers.
- Assess the connection between occupational licensing regulations and the underground economy.
- 4) Explore the balance between protecting consumers and enabling Californians to enter the occupation of their choice.

DCA did take part to testify at the second hearing, but to date, there has not been any type of report released from the hearings, as they were conducted to obtain facts and opinions for their review.


