

## ATTN: ALL WISHING TO EXPOSE DENTAL RADIOGRAPHS IN CALIFORNIA

On and after January 1, 1985, every dentist licensed to practice dentistry in the state <u>and</u> any person working in a dentist's office who operates dental radiographic equipment shall meet at least one of the following requirements:

- (a) Pass a course, approved by the **Board (Dental Board of California)**, in radiation safety which includes theory and clinical application in radiographic technique. The board shall require the courses to be taught by persons qualified in radiographic technique and shall adopt regulations specifying the qualifications for course instructors.
- (b) Have passed a radiation safety examination conducted by the **Board** (*ONLY* the **Dental Board of California**) prior to January 1, 1985. (This examination is no longer given.)

The Dental Hygiene Board of California, may in lieu of conducting its own investigation, accept the findings of any commission of accreditation agency (CODA) approved by the board and adopt those findings as its own. The board has chosen to accept the findings of the **American Dental Association** accreditation of radiation safety courses provided by schools whose dental assisting and dental hygiene programs are approved by the **American Dental Association** (ADA).

The Dental Hygiene Board of California reserves the right to request documentation of course content if deemed necessary. Such a request could cause delay in determining your eligibility to expose radiographs.
