# FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

## Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Definitions

<u>Section(s) Affected:</u> Section 1103 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR)

## Updated Information

The Informative Digest and Initial Statement of Reasons are included in the rulemaking file and incorporated as though set forth herein.

No public hearing was originally set for this proposal and none was requested. The Board provided 45 days' notice to the public for comment. No comments were received.

After the 45-day comment period, the Board deleted "(https://www.ada.org/en/coda) as set forth in" and "1905(a)(1)" and added Business and Professions Code section 1941.5 as the statutory reference in subdivision (b). This is a non-substantive amendment because the revised language directs the reader to the statute that establishes the Commission on Dental Accreditation standards as the standards with which educational programs are legally required to comply.

### Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

### **Consideration of Alternatives**

No reasonable alternative which was considered or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the Board would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which it was proposed or would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons than the adopted regulations or would be more cost effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provision of law.
