Subject Matter of Proposed Regulations: Registered Dental Hygienists in Alternative Practice, Performance of Soft Tissue Curettage and Administration of Local Anesthesia.

Section(s) Affected: Section 1118 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR).

Updated Information

Underlying Data

Economic Impact Assessment:

This regulatory proposal will have the following effects:

The Board has determined that this regulatory action would positively impact the creation of jobs within the State of California. The proposed language would require RDHAPs to hire dental assistants or other RDHAPs to have the physical presence of one additional individual trained in basic life support and qualified to administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation during an emergency when soft tissue curettage or local anesthesia administration takes place.

No public hearing was originally set for this proposal and none was requested. The Board provided 45 days' notice to the public for comment. No comments were received.

Local Mandate

A mandate is not imposed on local agencies or school districts.

Consideration of Alternatives

No reasonable alternative which was considered or that has otherwise been identified and brought to the attention of the Board would be more effective in carrying out the
